## PERIODIC HEALTH ASSESSMENT (PHA) INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Complete your PHA questionnaire through your AKO account. See steps below:
  - a. Click "Self Service"
  - b. Click "My Medical"
  - c. Click "Click here" (highlighted in blue)
  - d. Click "Periodic Health Assessment" (highlighted in yellow)
  - e. Fill out all areas in bold black
  - f. Ensure you click "Submit" once complete
- 2. Walk into Medical Readiness section at MEDDAC-J to schedule Part I. Do NOT call to schedule an appointment.
- 3. For Part I, go to the Medical Readiness section to pick up your "folder" and receive further instructions. You will then go to the following Clinics:
  - a. Optometry walk-in is between 8:30 ~ 9:30 a.m. If you wear glasses you will need an appointment by calling 263-4240
  - b. Hearing will require an appointment by calling 263-5050
  - c. Laboratory for Soldiers over 40 or those with an amber HIV. Walk-in is between 7:30 a.m.  $\sim$  12 p.m., and 1  $\sim$  4 p.m., Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday and from 12:30  $\sim$  3:45 p.m., Thursday
  - d. Vital signs walk-in is between 8:30 a.m. ~ 4:30 p.m., Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday and 1 ~ 4:30 p.m., Thursday
  - e. Walk-in for Medical Readiness is 8 a.m. ~ 11:30 a.m., and 1 ~ 3:45 p.m., Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday and 1 ~ 4:45 p.m., Thursday
  - f. Dental examination must be up to date. Call 263-4603 for an appointment
  - g. Well woman examination must be up to date. Call 263-4175 for an appointment
- 4. Once you have completed all the steps listed above, return your "folder" to the Medical Readiness section. Part II will then be scheduled for you to see a medical provider.
- 5. After you complete your appointment with the medical provider, return your "folder" to the Medical Readiness section and your Medical Protection System (MEDPROS) will be updated.
