The Tokyo Tower stands 333 meters (1,092 feet) and is the fourth tallest tower in the world. It is one of Japan's world reknown monuments. Hopefully the day will be clear and you will have a chance to really enjoy the 360-degree view of the Kanto Plain from one of the two observation platforms. On the lower levels of the tower many shops, eateries, a wax museum, the Modern Science Museum and aquarium can be found. After the Tokyo tower, you will see the Meiji shrine, Built in memory of Emperor Meiji and Empress Dowager Shoken. 


Odawara Castle and Hakone

The castle now serves as a museum for related artifacts of the 18th and 19th centuries where many national treasures are housed. After the castle enjoy free time in scenic Hakone-Lake Ashi area. *Options:* Take a boat cruise on the famous lake or ride the ropeway to the summit of Mt. Komagatake and see an excellent view of Mt. Fuji! 

Mt. Nokogiri Hike

"Nokogiri-yama" (Mt. Saw) is named after its own unique saw shape. The mountain is assigned as a National Park in Boso Peninsula of Chiba Prefecture. The hike will start off from the foot of Mt. Nokogiri and will reach the north entrance of Nihon Temple on the mountain. From the temple area you can enjoy the 360-degree wide opened view from the summit. Also the statue of the Buddha - the largest in Japan, 100-shaku (about 100 feet high) Kannon statue carved on the rock and 1500s of stone figures of Arahats are all photogenic and will surely give audiences a peace of mind.
Hike Rating: Easy (contains more than 1000 steps up & down)
Ascent to summit: 10-20 minute pavement road walk, 1-2 hours mountain trail from the foot of mountain up to the north entrance of Nihon Temple, 10-20 minute hike up to reach the summit.
Descent to bottom: 30 minutes - 1 hour walking path in Nihon Temple
Max elevation: 330 m/1082 feet
Wear sturdy boots/shoes and bring rain gear in case of inclement weather.
Entrance fee (Nihon Temple): ¥600 (adult) • ¥400 (youth)

Vehicle Rental Program

Policies

Active duty, retired military with SOFA status, DoD civilians, and their family members at least 20 years of age are authorized to rent vehicles. Individuals renting vehicles must possess a valid U.S. Forces, Japan Operator's Permit for Civilian Vehicles (USFJ Form 4EJ). The Vehicle Rental Office, which is located in bldg. 719 on Camp Zama, offers eight-passenger vans, 1.5 ton covered trucks, and cargo vans.

Late Fee:

A late fee of \$100 will be charged (per day) in addition to the regular rental fee for any vehicle returned 30 minutes after the return time on the rental agreement.

Cancellations:

Cancellations made less than 72 hours in advance will not be refunded.

Time Frame:

Vehicles are rented on a 24 hour = 1 day period.

Fuel:

All vehicles are provided with a full tank of fuel. You have the option of either filling the vehicle prior to returning it, or we can fill it and add the charges to your final bill.

The reservation policy is as follows:

- Vehicles are rented on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Make your reservations early! Our vehicles are in high demand especially on long weekends.
- Vehicle reservations can be made by using Mastercard, Visa or American Express \ credit cards, cash or personal check. Payment in advance of actual rental period is required.
