SUBJECT: USARJ and I Corps (Forward) Policy on Suicide Prevention

1. Purpose. To establish guidelines for USARJ and I Corps (Forward) in managing a synchronized suicide prevention program throughout the installation.
2. Applicability. The procedures and responsibilities in the memorandum apply to all personnel assigned to USARJ and I Corps (Forward) including Soldiers, Department of the Army Civilians (DAC), and their Family Members.
3. Commander's guidance:
  - a. The USARJ G1 has overall responsibility and oversight of this program. The USARJ G1 Well-Being Program Manager will provide structure and implement guidance for suicide prevention programs. The Commander, U.S. Army Garrison conducts these programs in coordination garrison and unit assets. Behavioral health professionals and Chaplains will provide assistance as required.
  - b. Commanders will actively engage with Installation resources to provide annual suicide training to Soldiers and DACs. Commanders will monitor Soldier access to services and programs that support the resolution of problems that underlie suicidal behavior and create a command climate that encourages help-seeking behavior and resiliency. Deploying units will implement a suicide prevention plan and ensure that personnel experiencing a major life crises have an appropriate level of supervision and assistance.
4. This memorandum supersedes Command Policy Memorandum 13-13, dated 6 June 2014
