MEMORANDUM FOR U.S. ARMY, OKINAWA

SUBJECT: U.S. Army, Okinawa, Off-Limits Locations

1. Reference AR 190-24, Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Boards and Off-Installation Liaison and Operations, 27 July 2006.

2. Applicability. This policy applies to all SOFA-status personnel assigned, attached, or otherwise present for duty with the U.S. Army on Okinawa, and their SOFA-status family members.

3. Policy. After following the procedures of the referenced joint regulation, the Okinawa Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Board has determined that the activities at six locations on Okinawa constitute a threat to the health, safety, and welfare of SOFA-status personnel. As the General Court-Martial Convening Authority for the U.S. Army on Okinawa, I am directing that the following eight locations will be, "off-limits," to all U.S. Army-sponsored, SOFA personnel:

a. "Shampoo," also known as, "Diana," located at 1-20-15 Misato, Okinawa City, Okinawa, Japan (in the vicinity of the Yoshihara District).

b. "The Ground" Tobacco Shop, located on the 2d Floor, 1-5-9 Mihama, Chatan-Cho, Okinawa, Japan (in the vicinity of the Camp Lester Main Gate).

c. "Naha Music," formerly known as, "The Stage," Naha City, Okinawa, Japan (in the vicinity of downtown Naha).

d. "Takahara 'Haunted' Hotel," Ishado, Nakagusuku Village, Okinawa, Japan (east of Futenma).

e. "Club Hideaway," B.C. Street, Okinawa City, Okinawa, Japan (in the vicinity of Kadena Air Base Gate 2).

f. "Tokyo Shoten Bookstore," Highway 23 at 820-6 Kamisedo, Chatan-Cho, Okinawa, Japan (in the vicinity of Kadena Air Base Gate 5), and the "Tokyo Shoten Bookstore," Wakasa, Naha City (in the vicinity of downtown Naha); and,

g. All events sponsored by, "Parties International," to include its, "Party Bus," charters.

4. This policy memorandum is punitive in nature and violations will be considered for discipline under Articles 90 and 92 of the Uniform Code of Military Justice for Soldiers, and the full range of regulatory and administrative sanctions for civilians, family members, and contractors. This memorandum will remain in effect until superseded or rescinded.
