SUBJECT: Battalion Policy Memorandum #5 -- Reservation of Authority to Execute UCMJ

1. References:

- a. Manual for Courts-Martial, United States, 2008 Edition.
- b. U.S. Army, Pacific (USARPAC) Supplement 1 to AR 27-10, 16 November 2005.

2. Purpose. To identify offenses reserved to the Battalion Commander to execute non-judicial punishment.

3. Policy. I reserve authority to execute all non-judicial punishment or adverse administrative action for:

- a. All officers and all noncommissioned officers in the grade of E7 and above.
- b. All Driving While Intoxicated (DWI) and Driving Under the Influence (DUI) offenses, in those cases in which the incident is not prosecuted by the host nation judicial system.
- c. All cases of Absent Without Leave (AWOL) over 72 hours. Additionally, I direct that all AWOL Soldiers (no matter the duration) execute a command directed urinalysis immediately upon return to ensure they are fit for duty.
- d. Any substantiated form of spouse abuse or child abuse.
- e. Sexual harassment offenses.
- f. Drugs.


5. Only after my personal review and on a "by exception" basis, will I release non-judicial action authorization for battery / company level action.

6. Expiration Date. Until suspended or superseded in writing.

7. Proponent. Battalion S1.
