***NEW* MILPER Message 11-295, FY2012 White House Fellows Program**

The President's Commission on White House Fellowships annually selects exceptionally promising individuals from all sectors of American life to serve as White House Fellows. Fellows write speeches, help review and draft proposed legislation, answer congressional inquiries, chair meetings, conduct briefings, and otherwise assist high-level government officials. All interested Soldiers must submit their application to compete and receive approval to compete from the U.S. Army Human Resources Command, Leader Development Division (LDD), Fort Knox, Kentucky. ***NEW* Army Directive 2011-16 Changes to the Army Evaluation Reporting System**

Effective 1 October 2011, The Secretary of the Army has approved enhancements to the Army Officer Evaluation Report Form DA 67-9. Changes are to better align with current Army leadership doctrine and more accurately evaluate performance and potential of Army officers, and increase accountability and better inform a transparent Talent Management process. One of the changes include reinstating senior rater box check for company grade officers, senior rater successive assignments recommendations, incorporating a statement on OER if the rated officer has completed or initiated a Multi-Source Assessment and Feedback/360 (MSAF) within the last three years, and a reduction in short-term evaluations. ***NEW* Orientation Handbook for Individual Ready Reserve (IRR) Soldiers.**

***NEW* MILPER Message 11-318, Call to Active Duty Regular Army Program for Selected RC Officers. (significant changes and restrictions now apply)**

Effective 18OCT11, this message provides updated policy and implementation guidance for the CAD program. The program is now CLOSED to LTs and LTCs and WO1-CW5s. The

program is now restricted to officers with knowledge, skills, education, and/or experience in one of the following academic disciplines: Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math.

***NEW* ALARACT 384/2011, DTG: R 171135Z OCT 11, SUBJECT: Reserve Component (RC) Soldiers serving on active duty in excess of 180 days permanent change of station (PCS) policy implementation guidance.**

This ALARACT cancels and replaces ALARACT Message 053/2008 and provides implementation guidance for all references noted in this message for Reserve Component (RC) Soldiers performing Active Duty in support of CONOPS. The policies in this message apply to all RC Soldiers (including Retiree Recalls called to duty under 10 USC SECTION 688 or 12301D regardless of component, performing Active Duty outside of a designated hostile fire or imminent danger pay area IAW DOD FMR 7000.14R or designated hazardous duty area. The Army will PCS RC Soldiers to perform validated CONOPS requirements. An approval from the Office of the ASA (M&RA) is required for all exceptions to policy (ETP). See the message for specific guidance.

MILPER Message 11-176 Implementation of the Intermediate Level Education Advanced Operations Course (AOC) - Distance Learning (DL).

The ILE AOC course is available via distance learning web-based format for active and reserve component officers not attending the 10 month resident course. AOC-DL is the credentialing course required for LG officers in the commissioning year 1994 and later year groups. Successful completion of AOC-DL is required to receive JPME I and MEL 4 credit. Completion of ILE-CC is a requirement for enrollment into AOC. Enrollment is via ATRRS.

AGR, IMA, and IRR officers will enroll through their HRC Assignment officer via a DA 4187 (use approved sample). TPU officers will enroll through their units ATRRS operator. For more information, click on link below.

Exception to Policy: Officers that were commissioned prior to 1994 and that have completed ILE-CC are exempt from completing AOC and are therefore, MEL 4/JPME-I qualified. The memorandum dated 13 November 2009 approved by DA G3/5/7 Director of Training provides the guidance for Reserve Component Officers commissioned in 1993 and prior for completion of the legacy CGSOC or ILE-CC will be designated JPME 1 and MEL 4. Also, those RC officers, regardless of commissioning year who completed AOWC modules 3-5 per ALARACT 133-2005 prior to 1 Oct 08 will be designated JPME 1 and MEL 4.

Instructions and Information for AOC-DL Enrollment

Who needs AOC-DL?

-Commissioning Year 93 and earlier Branch officers are only required to complete Legacy CGSOC or ILE-CC to be ILE complete.

-Commissioning Year 94 and later Branch officers must complete ILE-CC + AOC to be ILE complete (MEL4/JPME1).

-Commissioning Year 93 and earlier Functional Area officers must complete Legacy CGSOC or ILE-CC + their FA qualification course to be ILE complete.

-Commissioning Year 94 and later Functional Area officers must complete ILE-CC + their FA qualification course to be ILE complete.

School Code: 701, **AOC Course Number:** 1-250-C3B (DL)**Course Title:** AOC-DL

Description: AOC-DL is a 12 month course conducted in a virtual classroom. The virtual classroom usually consists of a mix of 16 (RA/USAR/NG) students and 1 instructor/facilitator. Students are generally expected (on average) to complete one lesson a week which will include on-line collaboration with their classmates. Mandatory on-line sessions with your instructor will be kept to a minimum. The course is not a self-paced course and requires students to follow a schedule, keep up with their classmates and progress on a fixed timeline.

How to Enroll?

1) AGR, IMA, and IRR officers will forward their DA 4187 to their assignment officer for enrollment. **You must have a valid PT test and PHA and no current flags on file.**

TPU officers will utilize their ATRRS chain of command for enrollment.

2) Once the school request is approved at HRC LDD schools branch, officers will be placed on an OML based on their Year Group (i.e. 1994, 1995, 1996 will have priority and so forth). School reservations will be made based on available slots, and year group.

3) Be advised that a student enrolled in AOC may be bumped from their reservation due to YG priority. If a student is bumped they will be re-enrolled in the first available course.
