As you likely know, there was a recent sexual assault of a Japanese Citizen in Okinawa by two visiting Navy personnel in a TDY status. This terrible action has led to a nationwide curfew and time for reflection for all military personnel ordered by the USFJ Commander. A stand down to review the sexual assault policy and the curfew guidance is ongoing. Please review the attached documents and acknowledge receipt. In addition, once complete reviewing the attachments, please acknowledge that you have reviewed and comprehend the current curfew policy within Japan. Ms. Horiuchi will maintain a log and will annotate when you are complete with the required training.

One question that has come up is, does the curfew apply to civilians who are reservist. The guidance is this policy does not apply to reservist that are in a civilian status(not on military orders). However, if you are on military orders to include weekend battle assembly, AT, IDT, or on extended orders such as ADOS or Retiree Recall, the curfew does apply to you.
