Ten Steps for Sponsorship Success



Follow the links in these ten simple steps when sponsoring <u>incoming personnel</u> to help them feel properly welcomed to Japan. This information may also be provided to newcomers for reference. Helpful videos: <u>incoming servicemembers</u> and <u>incoming civilians</u>.

1 REVIEW THE SPONSORSHIP PACKET

Review the <u>Sponsorship Packet</u> and obtain the <u>in-processing checklist/personnel data sheet</u> which provides important details that need to be completed to move forward in this process.



2 CONTINUOUS COMMUNICATION

Contact either MPD or CPAC to obtain a copy of newcomer orders and always keep open lines of communication between yourself and the newcomer. Try to do the research and answer newcomer questions promptly.



MAKE LODGING RESERVATIONS AND HOUSING APPOINTMENT

Use the orders to make <u>lodging reservations</u> and <u>housing</u> appointment for the newcomer (and family). Leave water and snacks in lodging room for newcomer and family one day prior to arrival (optional).



4 ARRANGE FOR SCHOOLS AND PETS

Contact John O. Arnn Elementary and/or Zama Middle High School to set registration and enrollment appointments for newcomer family members. Make pet care kennel reservations as needed.



MAILBOX AND OFFICE ADDRESS

Obtain new <u>mailbox</u> for newcomer, and as needed, obtain new office/unit address. Send new addresses to newcomer.



DRIVER TRAINING & VEHICLE INFO

Contact the <u>driving/vehicle registration</u> office for more information on driving in Japan. The closest auto dealers are <u>ATC</u> and <u>Wellcham</u>. Pre-owned vehicles are also listed in the <u>Camp Zama Classifieds on</u> FaceBook.



7 MEDICAL & DENTAL CARE INFO

Incoming servicemembers are entitled to medical and dental care at <u>BG Sams U.S. Army Health Clinic</u> through TriCare. Incoming civilians can receive care on military installations on space availability. Here is more information on the Civilian Navigator Program.
