LTC Kinard Egleton commissioned as an Ordnance Officer in 2006 following graduation from The Citadel, The Military College of South Carolina.

His first assignments were with the 602nd Maintenance Company, and the Headquarters and Headquarter Company of the 553rd Combat Service Support Battalion at Fort Hood, Texas. There he served as a Platoon Leader, Executive Officer, and a Maintenance Control Officer from 2007 to 2010. While serving as the Maintenance Control Officer, he deployed for 15 months in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom.



Following graduation of the Combined Logistics Captain's Career Course, LTC Egleton served as the Support Operations Officer - Maintenance and Supply Services Officer for 501st Brigade Support Battalion, 4th Brigade Combat Team, 101st Airborne Division from 2010 to 2011. While assigned as the SPO Maintenance Officer, LTC Egleton was deployed to Afghanistan in support of Operation Enduring Freedom from 2010 to 2011. Following the deployment, LTC Egleton assumed command of Echo Company (FSC), 1st Battalion, 506th Infantry Regiment from 2011 to 2014. While serving as Commander, LTC Egleton deployed to Afghanistan for eight months in support of Operation Enduring Freedom.

Following command, LTC Egleton served as the operations (Adler 03) Observer Coach/Training at the Joint Multinational Readiness Center in Hohenfels, Germany from 2014 to 2015. He then served as a Small Group Leader at the Logistics Career Course at Fort Gregg Adams, Virginia from 2015 to 2016.

After completing the Command and General Staff College at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas, LTC Egleton joined the 1st Armored Division at Fort Bliss, Texas as the Division Transportation Officer from 2018 to 2019. LTC Egleton served as the Support Operations Officer for 1st Armored Brigade Combat Team (ABCT), 1st Armored Division and the Battalion Executive Officer for 501st Brigade Support Battalion, 1st ABCT from 2019 to 2021. Most recently, LTC Egleton served as the Command Inspector General for Tank-Armaments and Automotive Command (TACOM) in Warren, Michigan.

LTC Egleton holds a Bachelor of Science in Health and Wellness from The Citadel and holds a Master of Science in Logistics and Supply Chain Management from Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University.
