

## **Reinspection once JCI nears expiration** **(Including Motorcycles)**

***NOTE: Reinspection can be accomplished as early as thirty (30) days prior to the expiration date of your Japan Compulsory Insurance (JCI). Check your car's windshield decal or title for the month and year your JCI expires.***

- Proceed to any Army & Air Force Exchange Service (AAFES) Garage to obtain and pass a mechanical inspection.
- Proceed to any insurance company and renew Japan Compulsory Insurance (JCI) for 24 months or pay at the Land Transportation Office (LTO).
- JCI fees:
  - Cars: ¥25,830
  - Mini cars: ¥25,070
  - Motorcycles: 251cc> - ¥11,520
  - Motorcycles: 126~250cc - ¥12,220
  - Motorcycles: <125cc - ¥9,950
- Proceed to the LTO with your vehicle and renewed JCI document. Go through the inspection lane and pay the following fees:
  - ¥2,600 ~ ¥2,700 inspection fee
  - ¥8,400, ¥12,600 or ¥16,800 weight tax. (Varies by your car's weight)
  - (Mini car – Weight tax and transaction fee are about ¥3,000 as the Mini Car Office)
  - (Motorcycle -- ¥3,000 based on engine size)
- Return to the VRO within five (5) working days to update your on-post registration.
