KNOW YOUR OPTIONS



Option 1

For Service Members and their Adult Dependents, and Department of Army Civilians

Restricted Reporting

- Victim receives medical treatment and counseling
- No investigation conducted. Offender(s) are not held accountable.
- Legal Counsel
- Victim can report confidentially to a:
 - Sexual Assault Response Coordinator (SARC)
 - Victim Advocate (VA)
 - Healthcare Providers

Option 2

For Service Members, Department of Army Civilians their Adult Dependents, and Contractors

Unrestricted Reporting

- Victim receives medical treatment and counseling
- Official investigation conducted. Offender(s) may be held accountable.
- Legal Counsel
- Expedited Transfer. Military Protective Order (MPO)
- Victim can report to any of the below resources for assistance:
 - Chain of Command
 - SHARP Professional
 - MP on post, 911
 - Japanese police off post, 110
 - Healthcare Providers
 - DoD Safe Helpline
 - Criminal Investigators
 - Staff Judge Advocate

CATCH a Serial Offender Program

Participation is anonymous and voluntary for both Restricted and Unrestricted Reports*. Victim can decline to participate in the process at any point, even after being notified that there was a match.

Military Sexual Trauma (MST)

Veterans Affairs provides Free treatment for any physical or mental health conditions related to experiences of MST. No documentation of MST experiences or a VA disability rating is required to receive care.
