

Lieutenant Colonel Erik Mead Hansen was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant through the Early Commissioning Program in May 2002. His civilian education includes an Associate in Arts Degree in Criminal Justice from the New Mexico Military Institute, and a Bachelor of Science Degree in Criminal Justice from Boise State University.
