CPT Alena Leshchyk was born in Belarus and attended Minsk State Linguistic University where she earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in foreign language education and comparative linguistics. She also completed an academic year attending a Folkhögskola in Gotland, Sweden.

CPT Leshchyk commissioned in the Quartermaster Corps upon graduating Officer Candidate School in 2018. Shortly thereafter she completed the Quartermaster Basic Officer Leader's Course (BOLC) at Fort Lee, Virginia..

Her initial assignment was with Foxtrot Forward Support Company (FSC), 2nd Battalion, 15th Field Artillery Regiment, 2nd Infantry Brigade Combat Team (IBCT), 10th Mountain Division (Light Infantry) at Fort Drum, New York where she served as the Maintenance Control Officer and Company Executive Officer.
