



Command Sergeant Major Corey A. Agin was born and raised in the state of New Jersey. After graduating from Hopewell Valley Central High School, he enlisted in the United States Army and started One Station Unit Training at Fort Knox, Kentucky on October 1st, 2003. Upon completion he was awarded the Military Occupational Specialty (MOS) of Abrams Systems Maintainer. In 2007, he attended Advanced Individual Training at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri and was awarded the MOS of Motor Transport Operator.

His Duty Assignments and positions include: Fort Stewart, GA where he was assigned as a Track Vehicle Recovery Specialist with the 3rd BN, 7th Infantry Regiment from 2004 until 2007; Fort Bragg, NC where he served as a Heavy Vehicle Operator with the 403rd ICTC from 2007 until 2009; Camp Stanley, South Korea where he served as a Squad Leader with the 46th Trans Co from 2009 until 2011; Joint Base Lewis McChord (JBLM) where he served as a Squad Leader and Section Sergeant with the 125th FSC from 2011 until 2015; Fort Campbell, KY where he served as a Section Sergeant with the 716th MP BN from 2015 until 2017; Fort Leonard, MO where he was assigned to B Co, 58th Trans BN as a Drill Sergeant and Senior Drill Sergeant from 2017 until 2019. Sergeant Major Agin returned to JBLM a second time and served as a Platoon Sergeant within the 2nd SBCT for A Co, 2nd BSB, and with G Co. FSC, 2nd BN, 1st Infantry Regiment from 2019 until 2021. He was assigned as the First Sergeant for A Co, 58th Trans BN from 2021 until 2023 and was assigned as the Senior Talent Management NCO for CMF 88 at the Human Resources Command at Fort Knox, KY from 2023 until 2024. He most recently served as the Division Transportation Sergeant Major for the 1st Armored Division at Fort Bliss, TX, and is currently the 765th Transportation (Terminal) Battalion Command Sergeant Major at Yokohama North Dock, Japan. Command Sergeant Major Agin has four combat deployments, two of them in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom.
